WHAT WAS THE IMPACT OF SPENDING THE MONEY? The majority of children involved in interventions made better than expected progress in reading and writing and good

progress in maths. In 2014 SATs 100% of children eligible for Pupil Premium funding achieved Level 4+ in English and Mathematics.
