How has your school's spending improved PE attainment?	PE attainment, especially in KS2, has improved in some of the more specific sports such as Rounders and Cricket, through spending the Sports Grant on specialist coaching and then entering festivals or competitions. Overall, PE attainment has improved because all the children across the school have had specialised PE coaching and staff have benefited from the CPD and therefore their teaching has improved.
How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?	All children take part in sports activities twice a week, over the 60minutes and also take part in the daily mile initiative every day. Having more resources and equipment as well as quality CPD has increase sport participation.
How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?	By paying a subscription for a school partnership and being part of the school games initiative, all children in KS2 have had opportunities to take part in extra sports activities outside the curriculum, every child has taken part in at least 2 extra activities across the year. There are 55 KS2 children. 10 children every week also took part in a Netball development course and then competitions. 16 children took part in a Forest Green community Football led club after school.

How has your school's spending increased staff participation in extra-curricular activities and school sports competitions?

All teachers have taken in turns to support extra Curricular sports competitions and lead extra curricular activities. TAs have also supported clubs at lunchtime.

All staff have seen the benefits of increased physical activities and the impact on the children's well being. There is an action plan in place to continue to build on and even increase the level of participation even in other sports not targeted before eg. gymnastics. Things like the Daily mile are well established and just need edits to sustain this participation. The school has juts been awarded their Gold award from School Games so this would be something we would want to maintain and build upon.
